After a long access we find this ravine well dug and formed. Among lush forests and abundant water we can enjoy this "simple" descent if the flow is not high.

Access to Isard parking lot

We arrive at Saint Girons on the D117 and before crossing the bridge over the Le Lez river, at the traffic circle we turn right on the D618 to Castillon-en-Couserans.

Access to Isard, Araing and Pugues ravines

Continue on the D4 towards Bordes s/Lez and cross it towards Sentein, continue a couple of kilometers on the D4 to Le Pont. Here we turn right (sign Etang de l'Araing) to the parking of Freychendech.

Approach: (machine translated)

Approach to the Isard, Araing and Pugues ravines

We take the path that runs along the orographic right of the Isard and climbs to the Etang de l'Araing. We leave the detour that leads to the chapel on the right (there is a bridge / footbridge) and climb to about 1300m approx. Here we leave the path of the etang and go right towards the river. There is a small marked path to go down.

Tour: (machine translated)

A series of cliffs lead us to the first waterfall and after another stretch of cliffs we arrive at the second one. Both are boxed and with a lot of atmosphere. After the second waterfall there is only one more section of climbing and a small rapell to reach the confluence with l'Isard (on the left). Before we have an escape route to the left.

Return: (machine translated)

We can leave through the loophole to go to the path that goes up to the Upper Isard ravine or follow the river to the footbridge.


