Summary: (machine translated) 14m rappel with upstream 3m step		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) In St. Claude we take the D124 direction Les Bouchoux. About 500m after the hamlet of Devia we turn left, pass between the houses of La Burne and come to the bridge over the Tacon. On the right, after the bridge, we park the car.		
Approach: (machine translated) We follow the blue marking, first on the slope, then later the path on the left down to the footbridge. Beyond up to the signpost and there then half-right down (blue marking). Then follow the tracks down to the right into the streambed.		
Tour: (machine translated) A 3m step at the beginning is followed by a nice 14m rappel		
Return: (machine translated) After the pool at the foot of the 14m rappel out left and up the path. We meet the access path and follow it back to the parking lot.
