Summary: (machine translated) Almost collector's ravine, long combination of cars, you have to swim across the reservoir to return. You can also enter from the ravine of the Ceja, skipping the R35 of the Falón, although the return would be somewhat less hard.		
Hydrology: (machine translated) Possible, but there are areas with a lot of vegetation that we will have to avoid.		
Access: (machine translated) We have to be located in Dos Aguas, a beautiful Valencian village. We will leave the village by the CV580, after the curves linked exit we have a cemented track on the left uphill. We will go along this track for about 6kms until we see a hut on the right, and we will glimpse the riverbed in the background. With the return car we will pass Millares and follow the CV580 to Bicorp and at pk48 we take the detour to the left to the Iberdrola station, we will follow the road down as far as we can and there are a couple of areas to park.		
Approach: (machine translated) From the hut following down the riverbed until you reach the dike, or parking next to the ravine to immediately enter it.		
Tour: (machine translated) From the dam all are skills and four rappels, of 35, 20, 24 and 9 meters, some of them flown, and in one there is a marmita where it will be necessary to wet the feet up to the knees. Until reaching the Tous dam.		
Return: (machine translated) When we reach the Tous reservoir we will swim across it and continue south towards the power plant. We will leave by that shore and we will have to walk up to where we have parked. Or just after arriving almost to the reservoir, on the left cross country, climb up to the top looking for the ridge. To then descend and go up a small ravine to the forest track that will take us where we have parked the car. if we enter by the ravine of the Ceja, the return is arriving at the dam on the right hand side, look for the crest and mountain range. until arriving at the top of the Picayo, and to the car.
