<b>Hydrology:</b>		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) From Kathmandu on the Prithvi Hwy westwards towards Pokhara. After 130 km in 4 hours - if we walk well - we reach Dumre. You can also get here from Pokhara after 67 km in a good 2 hours. In Dumre, we turn north into the valley of the Marsyangdi River and reach Besisahar after 42 km and 1.5 hours. This is where the paved road exits (2011). Now continue on a dirt road for 24 km or 75 minutes to the village of Syange. This is also the approach if you start the Annapurna Trek from the east, i.e. counter-clockwise. Here or in the vicinity (e.g. in Germu on the other side of the river) we stay for the ascent of the surrounding canyons.
