Descent without great interest and also with enough vegetation, the only thing that could call our attention is its great vertical of 50m, generally without water except after rains. We will enter from the west tributary to make the descent a little longer.

Easily combined with the Rases de Trasserra and Runers.

We are located in Berga on the C16 or in Solsona. In both cases you have to take the C26 that joins them.

At p.k. 134 we have the detour to Vall d'Ora and Capolat.

On this small road after 2 kms we have a detour to the right to Capolat where we will enter. We will pass Sant Sadurní del Cint and after several sharp bends, in the last one on the right, which has a track on the left we can park the car on the way back.

We continue along the road and just when we pass the cut of Mal Pas, a few meters, we also have room to park a couple of cars.

We continue along the road, cross the stream and face the west tributary, right next to the sharp right curve, which leaves behind the tributary, we have room for the access car if we want.

In any case with a single car in one of the lay-bys will be enough since the routes are short.

Easy except for the 50m rapell.

After the 50m rapell we can exit to the left by a path somewhat compromised but that we could leave secured from above before accessing the ravine.

If not, we can continue along the ravine until we cross a small track that we will take to the left to the road, to the first parking lot.
