Many abseiling sections - some of them technically demanding.

The Passeier Valley, on the border with Austria, is rich in waterfalls and interesting alpine tours. The Rio Salto, known as the Breitebenerbach, is one of them. It is a canyon with many successive abseiling sections, in hard and compact gneiss. Only a few deep water pools, but technically demanding abseiling sections that should not be underestimated.

Hydrology:

Access:

Parking exit approach: from Merano take the road towards Val Passiria/Passeiertal and reach San Leonardo/St. Leonhard via the Timmelsjochstraße / Passo Rombo. 500 meters after the village of Gomion, take the second road on the left. Follow the road to the exit and park the car at a drinks vending machine with the sign "Psairer Genussautomat" parking entry.

Take the second car back to St. Leonhard / San Leonardo, at the traffic circle near the sports area take the second exit in the direction of the Bruckenwirt restaurant. Follow the road for about 5 km. There is a high bridge about 300 meters after the Breiteben restaurant. Park just before the bridge.

Shuttle 9 km.
