Long alpine rappel canyon with long access.

**Access:** (machine translated)

We park the car for the exit where we parked the car for the Purcaraccia: Via Solenzara in the direction of Col de Bavella. After the Bocca di Larone mountain pass, park in the first sharp left-hand bend. \n\nWith the second car, continue to Col de Bavella. There we park the second car (parking zone regulated and subject to charge).\n

**Approach:** (machine translated)

Jourdan/Fiorina now describe the Alpine variant of the GR20 through the Bavella Towers. Where the GR20 descends again towards the Asinao hut, the authors continue - pathless (?) via the Bocca Maro ("1634" IGN map) along the ridge and reach the next saddle before Punta Muvrareccia via Punta di u Furnellu (1899m alt.). Between points "1831" and "1816" you now look for the descent into the large basin, at the lower exit of which the canyon begins. Time required between 5h and 6h30min.

Alternatively, there is a less attractive but probably more comfortable access on the GR20 (non-alpine). Here you pass the Refuge Asinao at the bottom and then follow the tracks that lead up to point "1816" below Punta Muvrareccia. This may take longer, but would open up the possibility of an overnight stay at the Bergeries d'Asinao (the Asinao hut is being rebuilt after a fire in 2016, but will probably not be ready in 2018). Of course, you can also get here via the alpine variant of the GR20.

**Tour:** (machine translated)

Descent begins with a C30, 2 smaller rappels and the C70, which is not broken. Then alternate stretches of descending and walking with 5-6 rappels (max. 18m). Then from the right the tributary of the Purcaraccia. Here now 2 more small rappels and a lot of walking and downclimbing before this tour ends at the access to the (lower) Purcaraccia.

**Return:** (machine translated)

Either continue in the Purcaraccia (see description there) or descend directly on the access path to the (lower) Purcaraccia.
