Beautiful canyon with two parts, the first normally dry and the second aquatic.

It is strongly recommended not to descend the last waterfall (Arquero) in order to preserve the vegetation and the soft rock (travertine and tuff).

Hydrology: (machine translated)

Several along the length, except in the boxed area.

Access: (machine translated)

We must approach to Puertomingalvo by the TE-V-8111 road.

From Puertomingalvo leave towards Villahermosa del Río (Castellón), and when you reach the Ermita de Santa Bárbara, turn right, leaving the road for a track, first asphalted and then dirt, that goes down towards the river and the village of Castelvispal. After about 4.2 km. there is a clear fork to the left downhill; before reaching the farmhouse of the Juncosas located to the left of the main track. Take this downhill track in regular condition for cars until you get very close to the Linares river, to the threshing floor of an abandoned farmhouse. Park

Approach: (machine translated)

From here, continue on foot along the PR trail that descends from Puertomingalvo to the Arquero waterfall, well visible, opposite. This path crosses the river over a wooden bridge in fair condition. Continue on the well-marked path without taking any detour that leads us in the direction of the river until we find, about 15min uphill, a clear fork marked with cairns that leads to the upstream spring. When arriving in front of the limestone walls climb up the slopes on the left marked with cairns and with some small climb, until an obvious flat ledge on the left of the riverbed that takes us to the headwaters above the limestone barriers.
