<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) Rppel canyon		
<b>Hydrology:</b>		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) Take the A-1 past Rome in the direction of Naples. About 145 km after Rome (A-1 / A-24 interchange), leave the A-1 at the Caianello exit and head east on the SS-372. After about 40 km, the SS-372 curves around the small town of Telesse. Here you turn off to Cerreto Sannita (11 km) and from there continue to Cusano Mutri (another 9 km), then follow the road to Pietrarója over a bridge for about 3 km until you reach a junction. Follow the small road to the left until you reach the bridge over the Titerno, at the exit of the canyon. Park the lower vehicle here. Take the other one back onto the road to Pietrarója. The road passes the village. At the end of Pietraraja, after a quarry - at a small well - turn left briefly, then right along a narrow road in a northerly direction down to Titerno, past a turn-off to the left (1.7 km). Park the second vehicle here in the area of the two bridges (a total of 7.5 km).		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) From the second bridge, walk next to or along the streambed to the actual start of the canyon.		
<b>Tour:</b> (machine translated) The highest rappel point (of a total of 5 rappels) at the beginning of the descent already has the anchorage in the vertical; you get there from a tree (from which you can also directly rappel completely with 2 x 50 m rope). Despite 37 m real rappel height from the transfer point 45 m rope to the rappel makes sense because of the large pool under the rappel. Only partially narrow, but still attractive lime canyon with water flow; also possible jumps given.		
<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) Turn right and walk to the bridge in 3 minutes.
