Hydrology:

Access: (machine translated)

We must be located in Ramales de la Victoria. To do this we will arrive by the N629 from the A8 in Colindres or from the Puerto de Tornos.

We will be able to park the access car in the p.k 65,5, access to the ferrata and the caves of Covalanas.

With the return car or if we only have one car we will park in Ramales.

Approach: (machine translated)

If we have parked next to the ferrata we only have to go down the ferrata to the riverbed.

If we have parked in Ramales we will take the road to Hazas that takes us to the cave, we will pass the ferrata del Cáliz, a viewpoint and we arrive at the ferrata de Calera, access to the ravine.

After the first rappel, the flood of 2022 took away part of the ground and now the access to the second rappel is at a height of 4m.
