Short but very beautiful ravine, open, with lots of vegetation and, yes, with the riverbed full of logs.

Access: (machine translated)

Situating us in Vielha, with the car of return or if we only have a vehicle, just in the church of San Miguel, by the orographic right of the river Nere goes up a street, this at the end of the population becomes a track, we will follow it until the bridge over the ravine Sant Estève. A few meters before we can park.

With the access car we will return to Vielha and from there to Betrén, we will pass the traffic circle of the Hotel Tuca and after 100m we will find a forest track on the right. It is the old track that served as access to the ski slopes of the Tuca. On this track we will go up for about 4kms, we will find a sharp left curve and another track that crosses the ravine. Here we look for the best place to park.

Approach: (machine translated)

From the upper parking is immediate.

From the parking lot below we must cross the meadows in search of the forest, here we will have to pull orientation and small trails to go up the mountainside by the orographic right of the ravine without getting too far away. After half an hour of ascent we will arrive at the track indicated for the 2nd car, we take it to the right until it crosses the ravine.
