Summary: (machine translated) The descent begins at the dam wall. It is possible to rappel 10 m vertically down this. This is followed by a series of 8 more or less deep waterfalls.		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) From Ordino, follow the road in the direction of the Ordino Arcalis ski area. Park in the first large parking lot below the ski area. You can see the last 20 m high waterfall directly in front of the parking lot.		
Approach: (machine translated) Walk up the asphalt road for 5 minutes. If there is a ski trail under the road, climb it for 1/4 hour up to the dam. You are RD of the canyon, hear and see it from time to time.		
Tour: (machine translated) The descent begins at the dam wall. It is possible to rappel 10 m vertically down this. This is followed by a series of 8 more or less deep waterfalls.		
Engagement Numerous possible escape routes along the entire canyon.		
Period/ water character To be done in summer. Beware of the very cold water and the current when the snow melts.		
Notes Cold and very slippery canyon. Waste of all kinds from the resort. Yuck!		
Return: (machine translated) After the large waterfall, which is 20 m deep, continue along the torrent to reach the car.
