Collector's canyon with adventure equipment, almost all in natural. Open and very little excavated.

Hydrology: (machine translated)

In most of the route, it is quite open

Access: (machine translated)

By the N123 we turn off towards Graus/Benasque by the A139. Or by the N260 at the height of the Colladas towards Graus.

At km 12.5 we have the detour to Besians. After crossing the bridge over the Ésera we will see a track on the right we get in and park the car back.

With the access car we will go up the track towards Caballera and park near the Caballera stream.

Approach: (machine translated)

With a single car we can go up the track walking along the path on the left orographic bank until we pass the cirque and enter the riverbed.

With two cars we can access from the track where it crosses the stream or park a kilometer before (next to the cuts) and go down the path that leads to the riverbed.

Tour: (machine translated)

The first kilometer has nothing remarkable so it is better to access further down and avoid this part.

Later we have rappels of up to 45m very open so it is ideal for after heavy rains.

Return: (machine translated)

We will arrive at a track that crosses the stream, we take it to the right and we arrive at the track where we park.
