**Access:** (machine translated)

Location of Bujamé and Molina bcos.

On the road to Buenavista del Norte, with the return car we will continue towards the lighthouse / Punta de Teno on the TF445. At the p.k. 2,5 there is a deposit to the left of the road and a place to park, it is the control point of the access to the lighthouse. From here there is a PR to the Risco. Here we leave the return vehicle.

With the access vehicle we return to Buenavista, we leave by the road to El Palmar TF436, just past El Palmar we take the detour to the right to Teno Alto. We will go almost to Teno, about 500m before arriving we have on the right the track of the Abejera, we will go down this track / winding road almost to the end where there are some houses and we park where we do not disturb. There is a small crossroads where we have room to leave a vehicle without hindering the passage.

**Approach:** (machine translated)

Access bcos Bujamé and Molina

From the crossroads we leave to the right until we reach a house where the track ends and continues a descending path, first to the East and then to the North to go down to the bottom of the ravine, crosses it and goes up on the right to climb to an abandoned house, we will continue until we find an old track that we continue until we reach a small riverbed that we will follow until we reach the vertical of our ravine.

**Tour:** (machine translated)

We start right at the 120m vertical, a first 10m rappel gets us into it to then make another 3 from hanging facilities for max 2 people.

After the vertical the descent loses substance, we will only have a couple of rappels of 8-10m and skills.

**Return:** (machine translated)

When we reach the area of brambles we leave to the right to take a path, this path will take us back down, later, to the bed of our ravine, to follow it to the deposit next to which we parked.
