**Summary:** (machine translated)

Dry canyon, very vertical and of short distance, neighbor of Manzano, Buitrero,... With a combination of cars we will take more than an hour of walking.

**Hydrology:** (machine translated)

Once in the ravine it is not easy because of the steepness of the terrain.

**Access:** (machine translated)

On the CV20 at pk 21 we turn towards Argelita on the CV194.

From the village we continue along the CV194, we leave the Lucena turnoff (CV193) on the right and before reaching the sharp bend at pk 14 we have places to park.

If we only have one car, we park at pk 12 to use the access to Buitrero.

If we have access car we will return to the detour of Lucena and take that road (CV193), after passing the Masía del Moro and Mas de Perxano approx pk13,5 we will have a track on the left that goes down to the Canaletas, after 500m a track on the right that goes down in zig-zag, we will go down there as far as we can.

**Approach:** (machine translated)

If we have only one car, from the parking lot we cross the river Villahermosa at the height of the source. On the slope in front we will see a path that winds uphill, we follow it through some cuts with stunning views and will leave us on the access track. We will have to go up the track to the peak and then to the track that goes down to the head (in this case we would be on the left).

In both options we will go down the track almost to the end of it, in the last curve there is a path to the left, being already visible the basin of the ravine.

**Tour:** (machine translated)

Very vertical, the rappels will follow one after the other almost without rest. Its R53 is impressive, an overhang that will leave us great views.

**Return:** (machine translated)

We will finish going down to the river, cross it and go up to the road.


