Summary: (machine translated) Very simple aquatic canyon with only a few rappels without difficulty. It is a good option to start people but has a little long access and with a lot of vegetation. The first part is the Bco Cubars that usually dries out, only has a couple of rappels and would force us to use two cars. Here we will refer only to Tartera.		
Hydrology: (machine translated) Possible in the open areas to the left of the access path.		
Access: (machine translated) From Artesa de Segre we go north on the L512 towards Montargull. After Montargull turn left to Tòrrec and once there we can park in the village or as you leave the village heading north follow the track on the left about 700m to a double sharp bend where we would park.		
Approach: (machine translated) We go north along the track and turn left along the remains of another track to take a path that goes down to the bco de les Planes, cross it and follow the path that goes into the Fontfreda gorge, here we leave the path that goes up it to the right and we will go to the left to cross it to take the path that goes up the Tartera gorge along its orographic left bank. We will go a dozen meters above the ravine by a kind of strip until we reach the height of 600m where we turn left to enter. It is assumed that as of February 2020 it has been cleared and marked with points and milestones.		
Tour: (machine translated) We will enter just above the rappels, and then it will be a succession of drops, jumps and pools until we reach the ravine of Planes.		
Return: (machine translated) At the bco de Planes we turn left to take the access road or to the left of the bco de Planes a path that takes us to an old track that leads to the parking lot.


