Summary: (machine translated) Small descent that is worth it for its beautiful waterfall of 42m. Best after rainfall to enjoy the waterfall. ATTENTION: Prohibited between the 3rd Sunday of September and the second Sunday of April. You can not enter before 7am or after 5pm.

Access: (machine translated) On the AP7 we cross Juquera and shortly after (already A9) turn off to Céret on the D115, cross it and continue to Amélie-les-Bains-Palalda. Arriving at the village, we cross it and just at the exit we turn left on the D53 to Mas Pagris. When we arrive at the Montalba or Mas Pagris turnoff, we can park.		
Approach: (machine translated) We will leave towards Mas Pagris about 450m and on the right we will have the GR trail, we take it, we pass a couple of streams generally dry and we get to ours.		
Tour: (machine translated) Short descent and generally dry except in spring or after rains. A 10m natural rappel welcomes us and soon we reach the 42m waterfall.		
Return: (machine translated) We hit the road
