<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) Rappel canyon with a few small slides and some narrow parts, especially in the lowest part.		
<b>Hydrology:</b>		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) From Reutte on the 198 up the Lech valley to Stanzach. 500 m after the center of Stanzach turn right, cross the Lech and drive 2.4 km to Vorderhornbach. There we take the Hornbacher Landstraße L264 and drive to Hinterhornbach, cross the hamlet and continue in the valley until we reach the no driving sign. Here we park our car in a suitable place.		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) Now we walk down to the Hornbach, cross it and then walk on the orographic. right side of the Hornbach upstream in the direction of Petersbergalpe. Soon we cross a wide gravel bed that flows down from the Karlestal. Approx. 200 meters after the gravel bed, we turn left onto a forest path which after a short time turns into a hardly recognizable path to the Bretterkar huts. We follow this path up to an altitude of about 1450 meters and then cross into the streambed.

<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) Out of the gravel bed to the right onto the forest road and back to the car.

The access is really hard to find. After the gravel bed, we crossed a small stream about 200 m to the left and followed the path, which then exits in the forest into an unrecognizable wild path. There are a lot of fallen trees in the forest and you keep losing the path. Simply ascend steeply along the stream through the forest until you find the path again. There are some new anchors. In any case, you have great views during the tour. A wild alpine rappel canyon. (machine translated)

Scenic and beautiful canyon with nice rappels and some smaller slides. All hacks are fine so far. The access is sometimes really difficult to find. At an altitude of about 1450m there is a marking with the number 19 on the left. Here probably descent to the stream (we went further up and then had to descend through the bushes and in the stream). descend again in the stream). If you follow the markings, you should come directly to a point where 3 streams meet. Here you can ascend the orographic right-hand stream a little further. You will find a small slide (2m) and a nice rappel (approx. 18m). (machine translated)
