<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) Watery rappel canyon		
<b>Hydrology:</b>		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) From Chiavenna, head south on the SS 36 towards Lecco. After about 6 km we have just passed the village of San Cassiano and turn right at the end of the village onto the SP 19 towards Samolaco. We head west, cross the Fiume Mera, keep straight on after the bridge into the district of San Pietro (in the municipality of Samolaco) and reach the road bridge over the Torrente Mengasca via Via Tonnaia. Here, where you can also check the water flow, park the lower vehicle.\nWith the second car, head south up the mountainside, following the signs for Monastero. After about 1.5 km, the tarred road exits (410 m above sea level) and we park the second car in a suitable place near the chapel.		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) We now follow the path on foot to the mountain huts of Motto dei Damini. This initially heads NNW, then turns SW and finally heads towards the Mengasca valley. From the Motto dei Damini mountain huts (670m a.s.l.), continue along the trail, climbing slightly to the SSW (black plastic pipe in the ground) until you reach the next stream cut. 20m further on - path now on the edge of the slope - down to the right, always following the red markings into the streambed. If you do not have a second vehicle available for this conversion, you can also climb up the orographic right-hand slope of the Mengasca. The initial path loses itself in the forest and we ascend without a path until we reach the path to Alpe Motto dei Damini. Turn right here and continue as described above (access from below approx. 2 hours).		
<b>Tour:</b> (machine translated) A sequence of beautiful abseils, interrupted by short walks and downclimbs. The C 55 in the wide beam is impressive. However, this can also be rappelled approx. 10m around the corner (cross rappel), then there are still 46m to go.		
<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) After the last rappel into the swimming pools in the streambed, descend a little, then turn right out onto the slope and down to the car.

Last part of the access: after the houses, follow the trail upwards to a chute, immediately after the first gulch follow the steep tracks downwards, cross the second small gulch, then follow the red dots (poorly visible) on the trees downwards. There are also cairns in places. Anchors all ok. At the highest rappel, either rappel directly in the watercourse, or climb up the handrail and rappel from there (partly in the water) - from this stand, the intermediate stand can also be reached "in fall line" (it does not need 2 deviations, as described in the book).
