Access: (machine translated) From Cañamares towards Cañizares on the CM210, after the tunnel at km 34 there is a track on the left that leads to Santa Cristina. Follow the track. https://es.wikiloc.com/rutas-descenso-de-barrancos/hoz-somera-tramo-inferior-18227316		
Approach: (machine translated) From Santa Cristina we take the ascending track, once we reach the high area, a descent begins where there is an intersection with another track, we must take the track on the right. We continue descending until we reach a small esplanade where we find the riverbed (before reaching the Tobillas bridge). We will continue a small little marked path that runs parallel to the riverbed, crossing it several times, until we reach the beginning of the ravine. https://es.wikiloc.com/rutas-descenso-de-barrancos/hoz-somera-tramo-inferior-18227316		
Tour: (machine translated) The ravine consists of 6 rappels, after the first 4 the riverbed leads us to a chaos of blocks in which we can enter through the center and exit either by a siphon of 2 meters or through a small window. Two rappels later we are deposited in the confluence with the Guadiela river, which can present complications if the flow of this one is high.		
Return: (machine translated) You can go along the Guadiela river until you reach a staircase where you have to go out, or parallel to the river on its right bank there is a very little marked path that will avoid going down the riverbed and leads us to the same metal staircase. 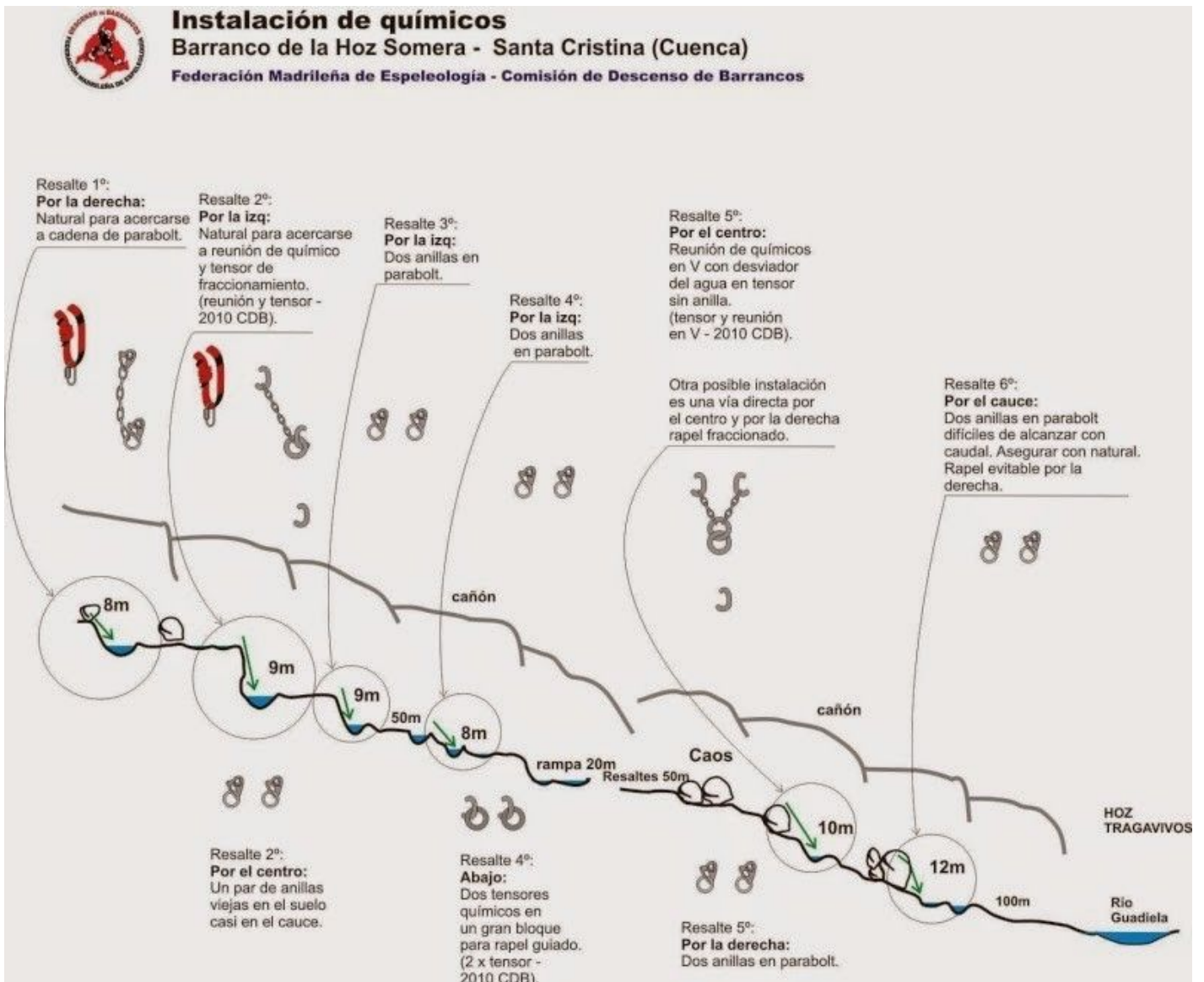
