Impressive waterfalls up to almost 50m high to descend after rain or during thaw. If the Jordan is strong, it's time to try these waterfalls in almost adventure terrain and equipment. 4 waterfalls to know.

Access: (machine translated)

On the A21 (Pamplona-Jaca), we will turn off at Sigües (Roncal Valley) onto the A137, after passing the Yesa reservoir. We will continue straight on towards Roncal. When we pass Navarra the road becomes the Na137.

We will continue towards Isaba and then towards France and the Belagua pass.

We continue along the road towards the pass, after the second sharp bend (right) we have the detour to the left to the Venta de Juan Pito. We park the return car at the Venta de Juan Pito.

With the access car we continue 3 kms towards the pass, past the Mirador de Belgua we have parking on the left next to the GR.

Approach: (machine translated)

We will follow the GR towards the West to go over the different waterfalls, we will enter the one we choose.

Tour: (machine translated)

The first 3 waterfalls are very vertical, the fourth more steeply sloping

Return: (machine translated)

The 4 meet at its base to form the stream of the Jordan ravine, we will go down to the access path to the Jordan and from here to the Venta de Juan Pito. If we only have one car at the top we will have to walk up to it.
