Also known as Torrent dels Porxos is a discreet descent of the Berguedà area attached to Rasos de Peguera. Opened years ago by members of EGAN (for more info contact them), it is a small torrent with an upwelling that in its final part usually carries at least a trickle of water. Easy rappels from trees, lots of climbing skills and a lush environment.

**Access:** (machine translated)

Located in Berga and leaving towards Sant Llorenç de Morunys by the BV4241, before the p.k. 2 we have the detour to the right Rasos de Peguera by the BV4243.

We will go up this beautiful road, surrounded by forests and open meadows to the south, until p.k. 9. Here we have room to park on the left side of the road in an esplanade with great views.

From the esplanade we have a track that goes down to the Hermitage of Sant Llorenç dels Porxos, impressive the place where the hermitage is and that we should not forget to visit on the return of the ravine.

**Approach:** (machine translated)

We go back a few meters along the road until we reach the torrent.

We will access from there

**Tour:** (machine translated)

Except during the rainy season or thaws, the ravine will be dry in its first part, once we pass the junction with the path of ascent we will find an upwelling that gives a trickle of water (to take into account).

**Return:** (machine translated)

When we reach Castellar, we will take the track on the left and 100m later the blue and white marked path that will take us back to the hermitage and from there to the road.
