Summary: (machine translated) Canyon with adventure facilities and others of opening, long but very nice approach through beech forests. The part of the waterfall of almost 60m is spectacular. Access: (machine translated) We must be located in Eratsun. On the NA170 between Leitzza and Doneztebe, at km. 16.4 we have the detour by NA4031 to Eratsun. We cross the Ezcurra river and just at kilometer 1 we have a very sharp left curve, on the right a track that crosses our river. We can park the car here to return. We continue along the road to Eratsun and park in the village.		
Approach: (machine translated) Access to the Basakais and Aneskula banks Behind the church there is a track that goes up the slope towards the mountain, we must orient ourselves to follow the tracks and trails that lead us south towards the head of our ravine. As a reference we must leave the Azkonzuluete peak on our left and halfway up the slope go around Orobiko.		
Tour: (machine translated) Open, very slippery and full of logs. Facilities in natural. After the confluence we have more fattened areas, beautiful and better formations of travertine but without waterfalls of so much importance.		
Return: (machine translated) After the confluence we can exit to the left along the path or continue along the "narrow" sections. We will go to the bridge next to the road and the curve of the road.
