**Access:** (machine translated)

We must get to Yeste for it by the A30 take exit 56 to the CM412. We will continue until after Elche de la Sierra that we will take a detour to the left to the CM3206 to Yeste.

At the exit of Yeste we take the detour to the left to the A63 to La Graya. Just before reaching Graya we have at km 10 on the right the exit of the ravine and a kilometer later on the left a turret and a track on which to park the car back.

With the access car we pass km 16 and a bridge, after passing it we have the detour to the right to Paules, we will park up there just where the road ends.

**Approach:** (machine translated)

We continue along, now a track, upwards and at the second left curve there is a path to our right that gradually gains height, going into the cliffs to climb to the top. Just to reach the top we find a track, we will follow it until we cross with another that we take to the right to continue along the top of the cuts, from this point almost 3km by track to surpass our ravine. A milestone on the right marks the point of descent.

**Tour:** (machine translated)

Very vertical and dry ravine that plunges into the Segura with almost no time to rest.

**Return:** (machine translated)

Once it opens we will have 400m of dexterity until we can exit to the right following the milestones to the road. We will follow the road to the parking place

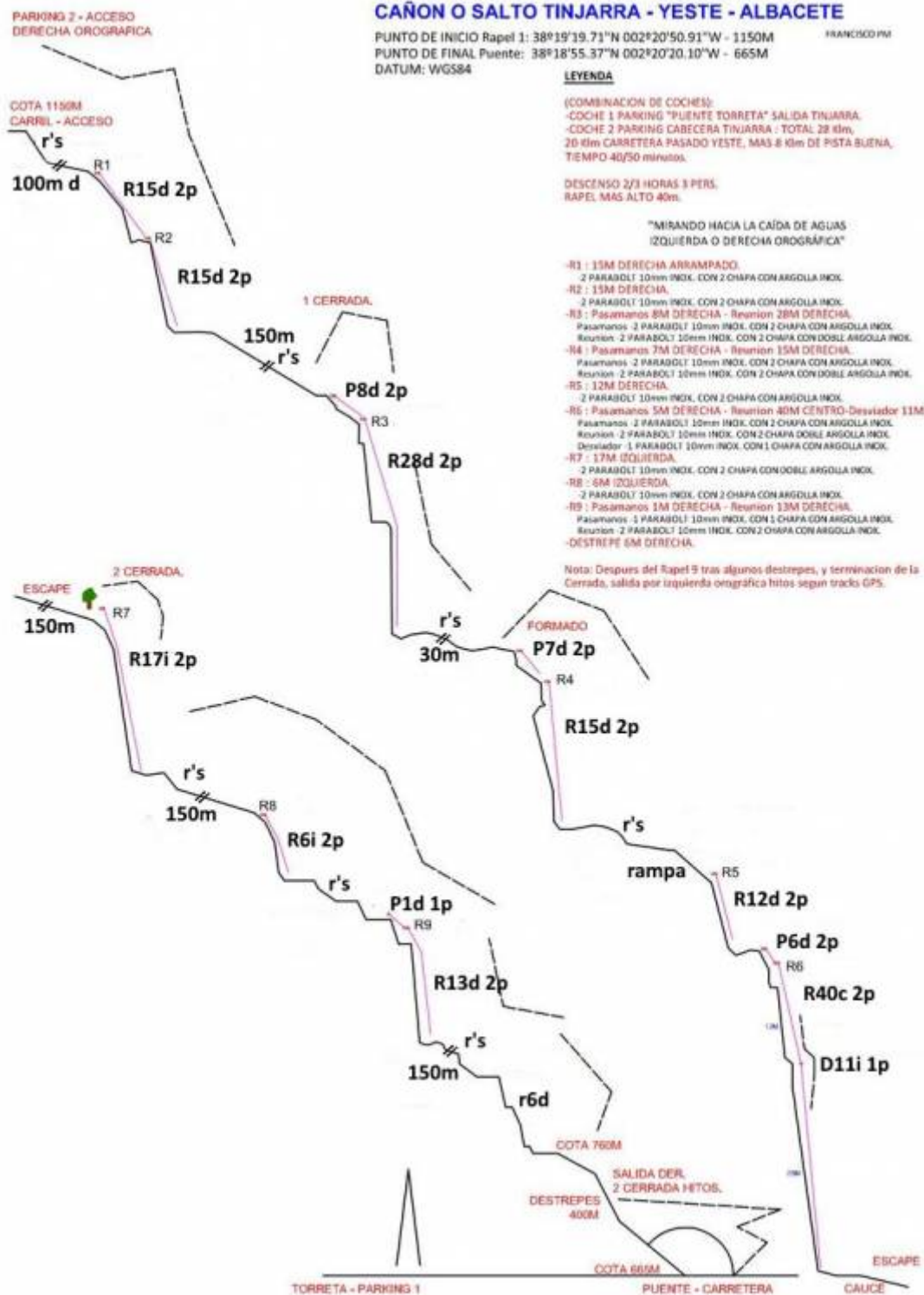
