Hydrology: (machine translated) In Aveller impossible.		
Access: (machine translated) Location Bcos Aveller and la Vansa We must be located on the C14 between Organyà and Seu d'Urgell. Leaving from Organyà we will have the detour to Montant de Tost on the right, we make the right curve, we pass the tunnel and in the left curve that is the access to the quarry we will be able to park the car of return. We will continue along the road to Montant de Tost where we will park the access car.		
Approach: (machine translated) Access to Bcos Aveller and la Vansa From the back of the village, a track that goes through the crops to the forest following the course of the stream. Arriving at the forest we enter and go down to the stream. Here begins the descent		
Tour: (machine translated) Very vertical descent, in which we will chain successive rappels (caution when rappelling with the chain and the marmite traps) and with its final part in which we will have 30-25-50 to reach the Vansa river. Evaluate before climbing the flow of the Vansa river because all the return is done by it and can have delicate points.		
Return: (machine translated) After the R6 and the chaos of La Vansa, the narrows open up and we see a track that takes us up to the quarry and the road where we park.
