From Ponferrada on the LE-142 to Compludo. Just at the village of El Acebo we have the detour to the right to Compludo and Carracedo de Compludo by the LE-5329.

Once on this road we will go to a right curve where the road to Carracedo comes out in front of us, we will get in and after a km we have a bridge over the river, we park the return car or if we have no combination, the car we take.

With the access car we will go up to the village of Carracedo, just at the entrance there is where to park.

If we go with only one car we will have to walk up the road to the village.

From the sign "Carretera de Montaña", there is a path on the right that goes down to the stream, we follow it until the first installation.

Tour: (machine translated)

Nice descent that, from time to time, is sabotaged by the people of the village. Anyway we can always descend it in natural from trees.

In the middle part of the ravine we will have a couple of kicking areas.

Return: (machine translated)

After reaching the confluence with the Compludo River we will follow it to the bridge. Caution with the flow of this river!

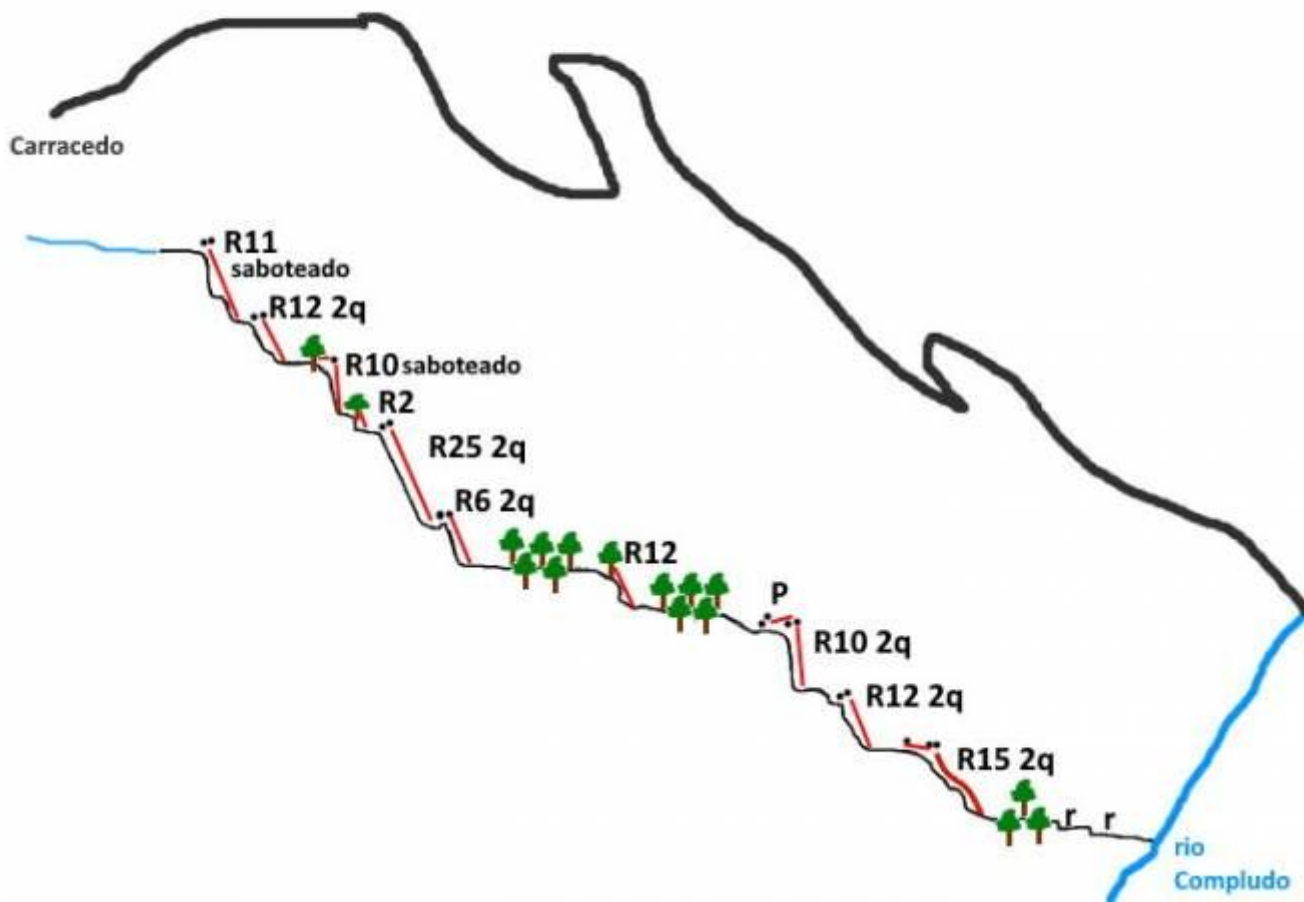
