Be careful with the headwaters that have quite decomposed stone.

By the AP68 (payment) or by the A3314 to Zuhazo Kuartango. Here we turn to Jokano and Arriano, pass Jokano and continue. At 1km from Arriano we have a detour, to the right to Luna (1.5 kms). After passing the church we turn right and follow the road out of the village, the road that continues straight ahead ends at the exit of the village and is the way back.

Once out of the village, after 200m there is a crossroads, turn left and follow it until the road turns into a track at the top. We continue a little further and park before the bridge of Zubiberría.

Enter through the bridge

Easy descent in which you have to be careful at the headwaters because the stone is decomposed. Much better after rains

You reach another bridge, from here you have two options:

- 1.- Go down to the village and go up the road.
- 2.- Cross the road and take a small path that goes up to the side of the river to the bridge.


