Situation Onil

We must arrive to Onil by the CV80.

On the CV80 take exit 13 (Biar/Onil). We continue straight on along the CV799 to Biar, after 300m we have a track on the left where we can park and on the right the approach path.

Attention to the great unevenness (step) when leaving the road.

Another option could be to park on a dirt track that emerges from the nearby traffic circle, but you would have to walk on the shoulder.

**Approach:** (machine translated)

Cross the road and take the track in front of us, go through the metal gate and continue until it turns to the left.

We will continue straight ahead upwards following some milestones to a water trough at the top.

When we see the milestone at the top we will turn to the right in search of the first rapell.

Another option would be to access it by the return. For it, after the metallic gate and in the electricity tower, to take to the right a flat track that takes us in few minutes to cross a dry riverbed, joining with a path excessively marked with milestones and blue marks (return). When we see the end of our ravine the path forks. Take the one on the left (milestones with black dots) that leads us immediately to the beginning of a small ferrata (ATTENTION necessary to use energy absorber).

It will leave us a few meters from the first installation, to our right and hydrographic right.

After the last rapell, we will exit to the right along a path with milestones that will lead us to some almond trees and from there to the access path.


