All of us who have climbed or descended the Perdiguero, in summer, through the valley of Remuñe have been impressed by the emergence that feeds this beautiful succession of waterfalls, you always consider the possibility of descending it until you finally see that someone already "opened" it years ago. For those who know this area, you will already know about the difficulty of access, the slipperiness of these canyons, etc., so from here we would like to point out that it is not a canyon for beginners.

It is the typical alpine canyon, quite open, although the loopholes are not easy, with a beautiful spring just where the canyon begins. Provide spare material.

Take the N260 to Castejón de Sos, where we turn off to Benasque on the A139.

We cross Benasque and follow the road towards Llanos de Hospital. We will not deviate and we will arrive at the end of the road where we will park.

We will go up the path of the Remuñe valley to the Pileta dels Capellans, almost half an hour. Here under the cliffs on the right is a small path that will place us at 2300m. At this point we will begin to hear the upwelling and we will see the cut of the stream, here we have a ring to climb about 40m to a small area ideal for dressing and get into the riverbed.
