<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) Behind this exotic name is the cradle of canyoning in Galicia. In the middle of the Rebeira Sacra we find this wonderful canyon that meets all the requirements of a great canyon, good flow, good vertical and well configured areas. Its only drawback is the walking areas between rappels. Obligatory combination of cars. It is better to wait until summer to do it because it loads a lot of rain. Be careful with the release of water from the dam.		
<b>Hydrology:</b> (machine translated) Not too many, not too simple		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) From Ourense on the OU536 until almost the p.k. 40, Vilalongo Turn left towards A Teixeira, 5kms to Pedra do Sol, turn left to Parada do Sil on the OU-0605, after 5km we reach a right turn with a bridge over the river Mao. There is a place to park the car on the way back. We will return to the OU536 with the access car, we will go back to Castiñeira, from Valilongo 2km until the detour to the right to Forcas. Cross the river Mao and go up to Forcas, about 500m before there is a path on our right that goes down to the canal, we can try to park here or closer to the village.		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) By the road to go down to the river towards the canal. Or from the Conceliña bridge detour, to follow the canal to the small sickle, where the PR goes down to the river.		
<b>Tour:</b> (machine translated) Areas of jumps, rappels and abseiling, interspersed with lots of walking in this beautiful canyon.		
<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) After the last difficulty we will continue walking 20min along the river to exit on the right to the road bridge.


