Scenic river walk with a few rappels and swimming passages.

From Solenzara a few km on the N198 we come across the river Travo, then turn west on the D45 In the direction of Chisa and before reaching the airfield access road on the right. After 7.6 km (from N198), always along the river, we cross the Travo, by now on the D645. 4.2 km further on, we drive in a narrow right loop over de Ruisseau de Coda Vacca. 1.5 km further on we come to the Pont de Bura (about 2 km before reaching the village of Chisa). We cross the bridge and then 550m further we turn left from the D645 at a sharp angle. We continue along the road - always keeping left - until the condition of the road or a prohibition sign prevents us from continuing.

Approach:

We continue along the path that connects to the slope. It mutates into a path. At a junction where the path comes up from A1, we keep to the right. Now the quality gradually decreases, is partly blocked by fallen trees or simply overgrown. Anno 2003 there was no more passage for us and so we climbed at E2 into the path. Here you can now in Bachbetaufwärts to E1, if no insurmountable obstacle is in the way.\nIn the years 2015 u. 2016 have a lone fighter or a small group on the "path" fought through until they met in the upper valley again on a better path condition. Tour:

We walk, slide and swim downstream. From time to time also a rappel. The first exit awaits us at the footbridge. After that, there are still attractive passages, especially the one immediately before the second exit.

Return:

At A1 (suspension bridge/concrete footbridge) go out to the left and take the path that leads back to Chisa.\nAlso at A2 go up to the left and onto the same path that goes up from A1.
