Generally dry canyon where the most remarkable part is its final part in which 3 rappels are linked to go down to the track.

Possible outside of the zones fattened by the orographic right to the access path.

Access: (machine translated)

We are located in Ainsa (N260), we will take the A138 towards France through the Bielsa tunnel. After a few kilometers we will pass through Labuerda and at pk57 we arrive at Escalona. We will continue towards France passing through Lafortunada until the detour to the valley of Chistau/Gistaín (A2609).

We will go along this road until the detour to Saravillo/Ibon de Plan, we will go up to the village until the barrier where we will have to pay the 3€ to continue along the track of Ibon de Plan or Basa de Mora, about 4kms later we will cross the ravine. We park here

Access: Gallinés sup and inf

By the bed or by the side until we find a rocky area on our left where we will go up to a small path. This path will make us cross another rocky area and a forest before taking us to the riverbed again. We will continue climbing another half hour to overcome a forest and where two small valleys meet, we will enter the riverbed.

We will continue along the riverbed up to the track

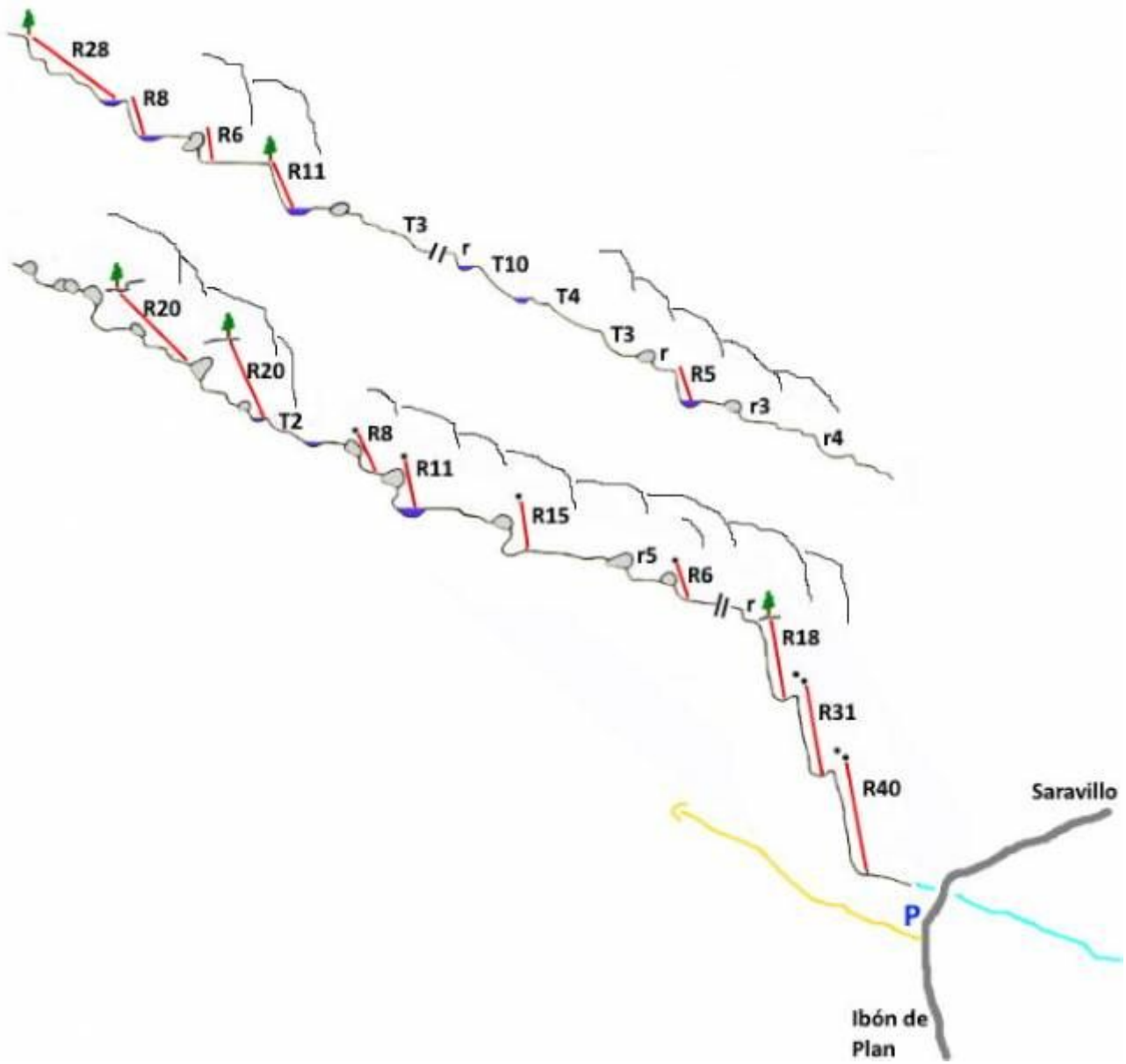
