<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) Also known as the Poppy or even the Eaglets by the final gallery. It is a wet ravine but without runoff, with lots of vegetation that can become annoying and with boxed areas, dark and very well formed. It is not as well known as others in the area and that gives it a plus. Essential combination of vehicles and caution if we want to make it after rains.		
<b>Hydrology:</b> (machine translated) If by the track that crosses the ravine		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) Bcos Arafo area Getting to Arafo We will take the TF523, road of the Teide, we will pass the viewpoint of Chivisaya in the p.k. 10, after that closed right curve we have a track on the left (place of the return). 10, after that sharp right turn we have a track on the left (place of the return), we can park on the right side of the road. With the access vehicle we will continue climbing up to the p.k. 17, past the viewpoint of Montaña Colorada, we have a track on the left. Here we can park or if we have a 4x4 get on the track 600m to the trailhead.		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) Along the track 600m to the same place as with the high vehicle. Then on the left we have the dry riverbed to descend.		
<b>Tour:</b> (machine translated) See topo Attention to the last rapel where we will need 2 ropes of 60m, beautiful final rapel.		
<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) We will follow the riverbed up to a house where a track starts, after 500m we will take the track on the left and another 600m later we will reach the road.


