<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) Open ravine whose main attraction is the initial waterfall, formed by a spectacular travertine.		
<b>Hydrology:</b> (machine translated) After the second rappel		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) We must go to Otivar and Jete by the A4050. With combination of cars: the entrance, in Otivar detour to "Camino de Moratilla". After 300m turn right to Bodijar. Follow the signs to Ermita Bodijar. At the exit, from Otivar to Jete, turn left to Itrabo (GR5300). After more than 1km we cross a bridge over the river Bodijar. Here we leave the car. Without combination we leave it at the exit.		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) With combination is immediate, without it we go up the return road (that leaves from where we have parked) and continue for 40min. It will take us to the hermitage		
<b>Tour:</b> (machine translated) The most impressive is the initial waterfall. The rest you have to be very careful because the rock is quite decomposed and is an area of fruit trees. fruit trees		
<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) At the end of the road, we take a track that we follow down and leaves us where we have parked.
