One of the best canyons of the massif, well formed, interesting rappels, marmites and many fattened areas. It can be extended entering through the Bugaders torrent, and leaving through the Pont torrent.

Re-equipped by the Federació Catalana de Espelogia with stainless steel chemicals, it can have some marmite with water after rains.

Situation bcos Sajolida, Bugaders and Pont

Once in the village we will look for the signs to get to the restaurant Vinya Nova where we will park.

Approach: (machine translated)

Accesses to Sajolida, Bugaders and Pont banks

We leave by the track on the right towards the Torrent del Pont, which we will go up by its fixed ropes or we leave to the right by a path that goes up to a hill where we find a cairn and red paint marks. We will follow the marks and cairns to the Clot de Sajolida. If we want to do Bugaders we will follow this path for a while until the next stream.

Tour: (machine translated)

A classic in the area, very well formed, with a first part of skills that gradually gain height until reaching the second half in which we link abseil after abseil to descend back to the Pont.

We will be able to go out on the uphill trail or descend by rappelling down the Pont
