Summary: (machine translated) A rappel and jump canyon that leads into the deep gorge of the Torrente Maé. Well worth a visit when the pools are free of gravel.		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) From Longarone take the SP251 in Val Zoldo. Turn off to Soffranco and take the first left in the village. Follow the very narrow road to the bridge over the Rui Maor. The striking 'Calgeron' basin is visible above. Park here.		
Approach: (machine translated) Follow the road briefly to a house, then turn right up a sand road to a fountain where hiking trail 579 crosses. Cross the hiking trail to the right into the valley and join it at a wooden bridge. You can also climb half right at the fountain up to 800m on a path. In this part, however, there are only downclimbs and a 15m rappel.		
Tour: (machine translated) 7 rappels up to 40m, some of which can also be jumped. Possible jumps up to 12m. In the Maé, drift down another 100m before you can get out on the right in the area of a landslide. Whether you can continue through the depth and 4.5km long gorge of the Mae would have to be tried out by a group experienced in white water.		
Return: (machine translated) Steeply through the forest on an old path back to the car.
