Summary: (machine translated) Vertical ravine in Los Gigantes, is under access restrictions according to the Plan Rector de Uso y Gestión del Parque Rural de Teno (PRUG) by which it can not be done between February 1 and June 30. A descent to plan very well both for the limitations, time it takes to perform, material, precautions for the output (small climb that we will have to overcome), etc.. Within the Special Protection Area for Birds (SPA), it would be prohibited between February and July. In addition, it is under access restrictions according to the Teno Rural Park Use and Management Plan (PRUG). Hydrology: No		
Access: (machine translated) On the road to Buenavista del Norte, with the return car we will continue towards the lighthouse/point of Teno, 500m before arriving we can leave the return car. With the access car, again in Buenavista, we take the road to El Palmar TF436, just past El Palmar we take the detour to the right to Teno Alto. Once in Teno, we will arrive at the bar Los Bailaderos, here we continue straight on towards Punta de Teno and then at the next junction to the left. If we look in Maps, it is the street of the Naturteno cheese factory or the parallel one. We are looking for a good place to park without disturbing the traffic.		
Approach: (machine translated) By a half track to the west, we cross a gate and continue through pastures, spotting the bed of our ravine in the background, at some point we will only have to look for the path that goes down to the riverbed.		
Tour: Ver topo.		
Return: (machine translated) Two options, we make a last rappel after the 75m overhang to go down to the sea, where a zodiac will be waiting for us. Or we go out to the right on an exposed path, where you have to go close to the wall to a ledge that is overcome by climbing, there is a point at the top from which we can secure the first to climb. We pass a fence and continue, now yes by a path, exposed, but path up until we left the cliffs, then we will only have to follow it to the road.
