<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) Also known as Lances canyon, it is a very vertical canyon, with hanging, exposed and very technical meetings. A place to enjoy as long as you have a lot of experience. After rains the waterfall can be seen from the road and is impressive. Better with combination of cars to save the hour and a half walk, and do not forget spare material.		
<b>Hydrology:</b> No		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) How to get to Valle del Gran Rey Situating us in Valle del Gran Rey, we will need two cars. The return car on the ascent from La Caleta to Arure, after El Retamal we have three very tight hairpins, in the second one on the left, before the tunnel, we have the jump to the right and a place to park. With the access car we will continue ascending towards Arure, just in the ascent, when arriving, we have a detour to the right towards Las Hayas. After passing the cemetery, which is on the left, 250m we have a track on the right that goes down to the reservoir, we must park here because it is not usually possible to go down.		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) Bcos Valle del Gran Rey We will go down the track until we reach the dam, on the orographic right side we will climb up and enter the riverbed.		
<b>Tour:</b> (machine translated) A first rappel to enter the vertical and then enjoy the equipped vertical. Be very careful with the falling rocks!		
<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) When we come out of the vertical we will do one more rappel and soon we can exit to the right towards the curve of the road where we have parked.


