Summary: (machine translated) Open ravine, in the middle of a beautiful beech forest, with two parts, a promising first part with a beautiful waterfalls, then a long stretch without interest that we can avoid it by paths on the orographic right to reach an interesting second part with the R30 as a climax, after this we will see a path on the right that we can take and save what is missing. Hydrology: Sí		
Access: (machine translated) Vitoria - Bilbao on the N240 to Zeanuri at pk 31. From the center of the village take the small road to Ipiñaburu and the Undurraga reservoir. We will continue along the small road to the hydroelectric power station of Lambreabe, where we will park the return car or if we only have one car. We will continue climbing towards the Gorbea by the same road to the Iondegorta reservoir, where the tubes for the hydroelectric production of Lambreabe come out.		
Approach: (machine translated) Direct if we have parked upstairs. If we only have one car we have to walk up.		
Tour: (machine translated) Nice first part with two rappels that promise a lot, but from here the descent loses in height. It gets us into an area of blocks and skills that we can circumvent on the right by fishermen's trails, we will pass a bridge and soon we can return to the riverbed to face the second part of waterfalls with 3 consecutive rappels. Once it opens we will be able to leave the descent by a path on the right.		
Return: (machine translated) If we do it completely, we will leave by the bridge next to the power plant. If we leave after the rappels, we will look for small paths to go up to the access road.


