From Pamplona on NA-700 towards Lizarra/Estella

Just in the p.k. 29 we have the detour to the right to the NA-7020 to Vidaurre and Arguiñano. When we arrive at Arguiñano we will park

Along the path that goes up to the San Adrián Hermitage

When we get there, we will take the riverbed, generally dry, and we will follow it until the difficulties begin.

**Tour:** (machine translated)

Two areas of canyoning with more open areas of lush forests.

In the first zone, Otsanzulo, we will have the path a few meters higher, aesthetic rappels to enter this canyoning.

The second zone, Arizulo, the longest rappel, 30m.

We will follow the riverbed up to the Puente de las Brujas bridge that joins Arguiñano with Iturgoyen, we will take the path to the left to go up to Arguiñano.
