Summary: (machine translated) Dry ravine in the upper part and with water from the upwelling. After heavy rains, the upper waterfalls are worth the effort. The ravine is located in Teruel but the access is from Castellón.		
Hydrology: Ninguno		
Access: (machine translated) We will have to go to La Sénia by the CV105 towards Fredes, we will have to change to the CV106. When we arrive at Fredes we will turn left on the road to Caro passing next to the "mas del Ric de Fredes" and go to the Collado de la Creu. Here we will turn left towards Beceite until the Boixet point, where the road will turn right and there is a track in front of us that is closed. We park.		
Approach: (machine translated) Along the track we pass by the Geodesic Point and the ruined Corral de Boixet where the track turns to the left and heads south over the cliffs. There comes a moment when the track ends and we continue to the head of the cuts until we reach the riverbed.		
Tour: (machine translated) It begins with two beautiful waterfalls (when there is water) that are mounted in natural. Then a more avoidable rappel to reach the emergence. Here we will be able to leave by the left (a milestone marks it to us) or to continue by the riverbed. Another milestone will mark us the change of shore to the right and a bigger one the exit to the left. if the milestones were not, after the emergence, to avoid the riverbed mainly by the right. little by little gaining height by the terraces, until seeing a green fence that closes cattle. there is the track of return to the car.		
Return: (machine translated) After crossing we reach the track. We will go up on the east side towards the Mas del Raco (also in ruins) until we reach the Beceite track. We will take it to the right and soon we arrive at the car.
