Vertical but accessible, when we can do it with water is a real delight, since they channeled the water from above it is difficult to find it with a thread but after heavy rains we can have the opportunity. Access: (machine translated) We are located next to Buenavista del Norte, in the village of Los Silos on the TF42. Just in the village, p.k. 11.5 Susana street comes out and there are the signs to Cuevas Negras, here there is a place to leave the car for the return. Access to Salto, Mantuba, Cueva Negra and Cochinos banks. We continue up to the traffic circle at p.k. 11 and take it up to Tierra del Trigo, once there we go up to the hermitage of Nuestra Sra de Lourdes, right next to it we park.		
Approach: (machine translated) Approaches to Salto, Mantuba, Cueva Negra and Cochinos bcas. We follow Los Rijos until we reach a path on our right that passes the Juan Alonso bank until we reach a track. We continue and find the water channel just at a bend in the trail on the left. We will go along the canal for about 600m to the head of the trail.

Return: (machine translated) We will descend until we find some pipes that we will take to the left to the track that takes us to the PR of Silos, we will go down until we reach the vehicle.
