Waterfall or jump of Guajar or of the Guájares, is a beautiful waterfall formed by the water that releases a ditch that circulates through the upper part. Beautiful formation and a third rappel of 55m, you can not ask for more in less.

Better to do it after rains to ensure flow.

Access: (machine translated)

We will have to be located in Los Guájares.

For the A44 coming down from Granada to the beach, we will leave towards Velez de Banaudalla to take the N323 downhill, at the height of the p.k. 181 we have the detour to the right to Los Guájares.

By the GR3204 we will go to Guájar-Faragüit and we will continue straight on until Guájar Alto.

Before kilometer 3 we have the bridge over the river and on the right a place to park in front of the waterfall.

Approach: (machine translated)

We go back along the road 300m to take the road that goes up, in the second right curve we go straight ahead to go up to the irrigation ditch. We will go along the irrigation ditch to the left until the curve of the irrigation ditch where we will see how the waterfall begins.

Tour: (machine translated)

A first rappel/drop to enter the riverbed, a second rappel, then we will go to the side to take a handrail to access the head of the third and last 55m rappel.

Return: (machine translated)

Immediately, we crossed the river and went up to the road.
