<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) Not unattractive fun canyon when there is water. Commercially accessible. Two parts, with the lower part being completely climbable. The shortest access would be via the private road to Solleric.		
<b>Hydrology:</b>		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) Take the MA2100 in the direction of Orient. Drive to a small parking lot at KM 13.		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) Descend to the right over a metal ladder and onto a path into the dry valley of the Torrent d'en Pregon, soon cross the stream and hike along the orographic left bank to the mouth of the Torrent de Solleric. Here turn left through the streambed and then soon ascend over the Cami des Barranc on the orographic right bank. Above the canyon, descend to the right into the streambed.		
<b>Tour:</b> (machine translated) In the upper part there are 4 abseils up to 20m, then a longer walking passages through the fields of Solleric. At the bottom, the canyon cuts in again, with 2 abseils that can also be climbed. Exit of the canyon at an artificial dam.		
<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) When you reach an artificial dam either orographic right climb out to the road or rappel over the dam (orographic left 3m+10m at natural rappel anchors) and after a short streambed hike several KM over paths to the lower parking lot.
