Situating us at the exit of Marbella towards Malaga or by the bullring, here we have the A355 road that takes us to Ojen.

In less than a kilometer we have a right turn with the detour to the cemetery on the left and the Cascada restaurant, we will get into this street towards the restaurant.

After 400m we arrive at the restaurant and shortly before a parking lot, in front of us a road on our right that goes up to the Sierra Blanca. We will go up until we find the end chain, there we will always see cars parked in front of the green classroom Gaianos.
