Simple canyon with a technical part in which we will find a 33m canyoning rappel that would be great with flow, but in that case the Canalda river can be too strong to consider returning through it.

From Solsona by the LV4241 towards Port del Comte or from Sant Llorenç de Morunys towards the Coll de Jou. On the LV4241 just in the pk18 we have a detour that goes down to Encies towards the photovoltaic panels, after 400m we have a detour to the left by a track in worse condition. We will park here if our car does not allow us to go on the other track.

We will continue along the track until the Font de l'Algassa, about 2kms of track.

A first part of skills in which we will cross the return path to reach the sports area, where we will chain 4 rappels, the last of them of 33m in a spectacular overhang. Then a last rappel in ramp to descend to the Canalda riverbed.

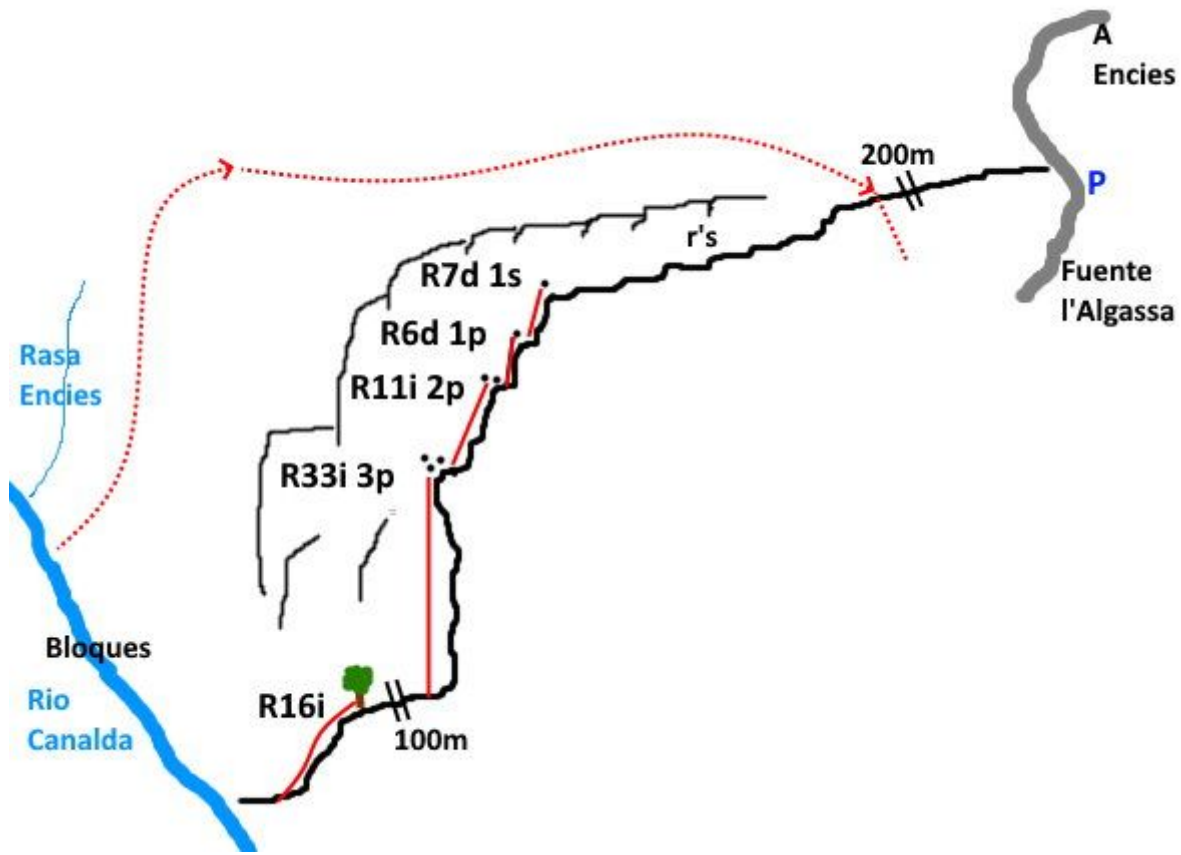
