<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) Bcos El Risco area We have to be located in the NW of the island, next to the Natural Park of Tamadaba, in the town of El Risco. Location of the banks Palmar, Juanjorro, Laurel and Molina. We will take the GC2 to El Risco where we will take the GC200 southbound, when entering El Risco we have a parking lot on the right to visit the Charco Azul. We could also go up through the village and park in the upper part but this always bothers the neighbors more...		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) Access bcos Palmar and Juanjorro By the path that leaves the village towards the channel, we will surpass the walls and we will arrive at the bed of Juanjorro. If we want to do the upper part we will have to follow the path that continues ascending. Access bcos Palmar and Juanjorro For the path that crosses the Juanjorro riverbed, we change of slope for the Lomo de la Cruz and we descend to the riverbed.
