**Summary:** (machine translated)

Simple but very long descent in which we will need a combination of cars. It has two parts, the first more vertical and sporty of which we can leave by the first trail junction. The second part is much steeper with very easy rappels, this second part could be done with only one car accessing from El Cavall. Generally without water except after rains.

**Hydrology:** (machine translated)

Continuous in the second part. In the first part in almost all the route

**Access:** (machine translated)

From Solsona by the LV4241 towards Port del Comte and Sant Llorenç de Morunys for the access.

By the C462 in the same direction for the return car or if you do 2nd part with only one car.

The access car, for the LV4241, in the p.k. 17.2 where we will find a sharp bend to the left and to the right an abandoned house and parking area. If we have 4x4 we can try to access by the Capdevila track until almost the head, 1km from the road.

With the return car by the C462, at the p.k. 10.1 we have the bridge over the Torrenteller, we continue a little further to El Cavall (left) where we will park.

**Approach:** (machine translated)

From the hut next to the road, continue along the track that goes to Capdevilla with magnificent views to the south. After one kilometer we have a curve to the left, another to the right and a small hill. This is the place to leave the track and turn right towards the riverbed along the slope. It is almost half a kilometer to reach the first rappel.

If we want to access the second part, from El Cavall, we will take the track of the Camí de Torrenteller, which first goes south, southwest, to get into the valley and then goes up the riverbed by its orographic left until crossing it after 2 kms, we will continue 1 km more until the last crossing.

**Tour:** (machine translated)

First part with a series of rappels and rappels that lead us to some equipped ramps and to the head of the vertical of almost 40m, we will continue through another area of smaller rappels to the tributary on the right (usually dry) where we can get out to the track on the right.

From here it is the second part, rappels of up to 10m and many chaos of rocks with very dressed areas where we will need pruning shears.
