Very aquatic canyon, to be done in summer, it is very little known and therefore with facilities quite deteriorated by its poor maintenance. Being in this area of gullies is a little frequented canyon, but it is a little gem. Easily combined with Zitziratze, Holtzarte and Phista.

We will descend to the French side until the col of Erroymenti. Here there is a track to the right and in that esplanade on the right, we reach a farm that we leave aside and continue down the track to a small esplanade next to the river where we will park.

To get here we will need a high car, if we don't have it we can park further up the hill.

Access as a more accessible Phista

Another option for all vehicles is to take advantage of the Phista access. At the exit of Larrau we see a detour to the right towards the Cascade de Pista. We go up the forest track to the parking lot.
