Dry ravine up to the Alcoy spring that gives its name to the descent, open and without much interest up to this point. Neoprene is not usually necessary except after heavy rains, the pools can be avoided.

Access: (machine translated)

We must be located in the village of Tous. We will arrive by the CV541 that we will follow straight ahead towards the dam of the reservoir.

Access to Pertecaste, Olla and Alcoy ravines.

After almost 5kms from the village we will reach a detour, left to the dam that we will not follow and straight ahead by the path of Pollet-Terrabona. A kilometer and a half later we leave on the left a detour that goes down to the reservoir, we will continue on the right, on the upper part. After a sharp left turn at Puntal del Boj or de les Bruixes we will see the high tension towers in the background, about 300m before a track comes out on the left. We will go down this track about 200m and there is a track in worse condition on the right, we will go down it until we go down to the dry riverbed of the ravine, just before a hut. We will be able to park here

Approach: (machine translated)

We will follow the track for a little more than a kilometer until we see a gentle hill where we can go down to the left to the riverbed. We could also go down a few meters later and enter the riverbed about 100m later. Once in the riverbed we will have to continue 300m until we reach the difficulties.
